- A. Secretary's Report (Julie Eisenhut)

 - 3. Fundraiser Update and Final Total
 - a) HUGE success with lots of donations. We think the "stress free" fundraising is the key to involvement rather than selling.
 - b) We were hoping to raise \$4,000 but we raised \$4,625!!!
 - c) We would like to continue this sort of fundraising next year and add an element of reward - maybe something fun for the school (popsicles, recess outdoors, free time?)
- B. Treasurer's Report (Nicole Mather)
 - Monthly report Budget is balanced
 - a) Due to the success of our fundraiser, we are able to roll over more funds that usual.
 - b) Current Balances Checking-\$16,698.17 Savings-\$5,126.76
 - (1) We would like to close the Savings Account and transfer the balance to checking account
 - c) Membership \$\$ rec'd \$6,441 (under budget \$1,200)
 - d) Membership Dues to State-rec'd \$3,008 paid \$2,847 in dues
 - e) Donations rec'd \$1,592 from Boosters at registration & GiveBacks and \$4,625 from the Stress-free Fundraiser
 - f) Hospitality-\$2,048 paid to date

g) Yearbook-\$8,928 paid to date

C. Welcome to Dr. Lori Bein & Dr. Brian Kaye

- The 5 Essentials Survey is still active and needs more participation from parents (teachers and students participated). The survey helps the administration gauge the level of satisfaction in each school and what areas need some improvement. Needs 20% from each school and very close at this point.
- 2. Construction projects are on time and under budget. 6 elementary schools going on at the same time. Staff and students have been tremendously flexible and patient throughout the construction.
- 3. 2024-2025 school year starting later (Aug. 29th) and ending earlier to get closer to the high school calendar year. They recognize the child care is an issue and have worked with the Park District to offer childcare coverage from 7:00am-6:00pm through August 9th. They are exploring other options and agencies in the area to help working parents.
- 4. Welcome Dr. Brian Kaye started as asst principal at South and has been in education for 26 years; 20 years in the district. He is excited to be a part of District 25.
- 5. Q & A portion
 - a) Calendar concerns over the 25-26 school year?
 - (1) This summer shorter, next summer longer trying to go back to starting in mid-August and aligning with high school calendar.
 - b) Has the kindergarten enrollment increased?
 - (1) Pre-registration has just started. At this point we have 387 kindergarteners, anticipated 424.
 - (2) 25 classrooms across the buildings, new gyms at 2 schools.
 - (3) 2-3 year transition until you see a full change in enrollment.
 - c) What are Dr. Kaye's goals?
 - (1) Making sure construction finishes on time for next school year.
 - (2) Full day kindergarten has a smooth start.
 - (3) Middle School math looking at the progression of courses from 3rd high school. Looking at various options and support for accelerated math to meet needs
 - (4) Teacher support both work/life balance and with instructional coaches in the classrooms.

 - 1. Thanked the PTA for dinner during Parent/Teacher conferences. They love stock-the-lounge and having treats throughout the day.
